Demonstrating continuous improvement in environmental performance through measuring and reporting on Greenhouse Gas Emissions to align with the GHG Protocol; effective waste management; efficient use of resources and implementation of effective biosecurity controls at PMNZ Ports and Marinas.

KAITIAKITANGA

As the kaitiaki of the areas in which we operate we are committed to protecting our natural environment by practicing the mitigation hierarchy of avoiding, remedying, mitigating, and offsetting any adverse effect on the environment. This is done by preventing pollution, sound oil spill response and management procedures, enhancing biodiversity and supporting regeneration and restoration of terrestrial and marine ecosystems.

INNOVATION

Through innovation, we strive to produce better environmental outcomes. We encourage sustainable procurement across all operations, considering social, economic, and environmental aspects when sourcing materials and services.

COMPLIANCE
